The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.169 dated 15.10.2017 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 21.2.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of

petitioners/accused Sukhdev Singh, Randeep Singh @ Rana, Paramjit Kaur, Sukhwinder Kaur and Major Singh and also of complainant Kanwaljit Singh and Baldev Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and relatives.

The learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.169 dated 15.10.2017 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
