LISA GILL, J.

This revision petition has been filed for setting aside order dated 03.07.2017 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana whereby the petitioner's appeal has been dismissed for want of prosecution as well as order dated 08.05.2018 whereby the petitioner's application for restoration of the appeal, has also been dismissed. It was brought to the notice of this Court by learned counsel for the respondents on the last date of hearing i.e. 29.04.2019, that possession of the demised premises has been taken by the respondents – landlords on 19.03.2019. As there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the matter was adjourned for today and it was directed that the learned counsel for the petitioner be notified of the date fixed in this case.

Today again, none appears on behalf of the petitioner despite learned counsel being notified. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed in default.
