They claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 4.12.2019 in this regard to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Annexure P-5 dated 4.12.2019 and ensure that no harm is caused to the
petitioners.

opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
