Petitioner is a prosecution witness. He appeared and deposed before the Court. He was cross-examined at length. After passage of considerable time, application has been filed by the petitioner to permit him to appear for re-examination on the ground that when he appeared and deposed in the Court, he was under pressure. In the facts of the case, learned Additional Sessions Judge has dismissed the application. It may be noticed that Gurdev Singh is alleged to have been murdered by the accused while intentionally driving the car in the reverse gear. The FIR was registered on the statement of deceased Gurdev Singh, who had given detailed account of the occurrence.

After lapse of 1½ years of the deposition, prosecution witness is now trying to wriggle out of his own deposition.

Keeping in view the detailed order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, this court does not find any ground to interfere.

Dismissed.
