SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 20.12.2018, the alleged detainee namely Gagandeep Kaur, has been produced in Court. Learned State counsel submits that she has been residing with her parents and the police has brought her from her parents house.

From the submissions of counsel for the parties, it appears that Gagandeep Kaur got married with one Nishan Singh. It transpires that he was married earlier and had two children from the wedlock. His first wife is residing with his children at the house of his parents and since the petitioner was arrested, the police sent Gagandeep Kaur along with her

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parents. It also appears that she wants to go back to the family of Nishan Singh.

Under the circumstances, I do not deem it fit to pass any directions in this case. Suffice to say that Gagandeep Kaur is presently residing with her parents and their custody cannot be termed to be illegal or unlawful. Thus, the petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to Nishan Singh to file an appropriate petition in case he so desires.
