Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 9.12.2019, in this regard, to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Sulinder Kumar, AAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P3) and photographs (Anneuxre P-4).

During the course of hearing, the petitioners have also made available copies of their Migration Certificate from Headmaster, Govt. High School, Barseen of petitioner No.1 and Matriculation and Secondary School

Examination certificate of petitioner No.2 which are taken on record and be tagged at appropriate place.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 9.12.2019 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
