Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.44, dated 28.06.2019, registered under Sections 379-B/411/34 IPC at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner along with co-accused had snatched purse containing Rs.3,000/-, having necessary documents along with Mobile phone from the victim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 03.07.2019.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Dilbara Singh, has submitted that Rs.3000/- snatched from the victim has been recovered from the petitioner apart from 'Datar'.

Investigations are complete. Petitioner is now in judicial custody. As per the information supplied by learned counsel for the State, petitioner does not have any previous criminal record.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is now in custody since 03.07.2019 and the

trial of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
