AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 32118 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Be that as it may, this court now directs the appropriate authority to decide the representations dated 23.8.2018 (Annexure P-1) and 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law, and if necessary, after hearing the petitioners or their representative(s), by passing a speaking order, within a period of one week from today.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Praneet, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, District Bathinda has been filed. The order dated 19.12.2018 has been annexed with the reply. It has been pleaded that in compliance of

the order of this court, order dated 19.12.2018 has been passed. The same is annexed as Annexure-R.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives. However, he states that in case of any grievance, the petitioners be granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
