By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.59 dated 22.3.2016 registered at Police Station Samrala, Police District Khanna under Sections 341, 323, 342, 379, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 20.12.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Sandeep Kaur, Simaranjit Singh and Jasmininder @ Mani

and also of complainant Suresh Kumar and his son Bharat Bhardwaj have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.59 dated 22.3.2016 registered at Police Station Samrala, Police District Khanna under Sections 341, 323, 342, 379, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
