The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 23.03.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the official respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner.

Reply was filed way back on 25.03.2019.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time on the ground that arguing counsel is not present. This Court would have adjourned the case but for the facts that order has been complied with. As per the reply, the representation of the petitioner has already been decided by way of a speaking order dated 20.08.2018, vide which complaint of the petitioner was rejected having been found incorrect.

In view of the above, the contempt petition does not survive and the same is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

In case, the petitioner is aggrieved by the speaking order dated 20.08.2018 he shall be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
