The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.630, dated 30.12.2017, registered under Sections 409, 467, 468, 167, 201, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that now offence under Section 13(1) of the Prevention of Corruption Act has also been added.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Balraj Singh, has accepted this. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has been in custody since 20.7.2018.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular

bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
