Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.185 dated 17.10.2018 under Section 376 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

Fresh power of attorney filed on behalf of the complainant today in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that pursuant to the order dated 15.11.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation, even the police has completed the investigation and submitted the challan. On presentation of challan, petitioner was admitted on regular bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Kaur, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required as challan has already been presented in court, the order dated 15.11.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.
