KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Learned counsel for the parties are not at issue that the period for which the tender was floated came to an end on 31.03.2019, rendering this petition infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that since the tender could not be finalized during this period as such petitioner is entitled for refund of the earnest money deposited by it. While disposing of this petition having rendered as infructuous due to efflux of time, we hereby provide that the petitioner make an application before the respondent for refund of the earnest money deposited and the application shall be processed and suitable orders shall be passed thereon in accordance with law within a period of one week from the date of the receipt of the application. Needless to observe that unless there is any legal impediment the petitioner would be entitled for refund of the earnest money deposited.
