Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing transfer order Annexure P-3 dated 22.08.2019 as the petitioner has not completed 5 years service in the School/Block and the post of PGT Sanskrit is lying vacant besides transfer of the petitioner is in contravention of the Teachers Transfer Policy Annexure P-1 dated 29.06.2016 and Amended/Policy Annexure P-2 dated 05.06.2017.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-8 dated 29.11.2019 qua the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-8 dated 29.11.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-8 dated 29.11.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
