This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 22.02.2018 registered under Sections 379-B & 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Kurali, District Mohali and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 28.05.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded; as to the genuineness of the compromise. In compliance thereof, report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar Mohali dated 11.06.2018, was received, wherein, it was reported that statement of the petitioner had been recorded; however, a person stating himself to be respondent No.2-Imran Momin had appeared as complainant. But his statement could not be recorded as he could not prove his identity before the court below.

Later on, the petitioner had filed application CRM No.42289 of 2018; seeking one more opportunity to get their statements recorded regarding compromise. This application was allowed by this court vide order dated 03.12.2018 and the parties were again directed to appear before the trial court for recording their statements regarding the compromise. Pursuant to order dated 03.12.2018, again a report dated 20.12.2018 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kharar submitting therein that none has appeared before her court for recording statement regarding compromise. In that view of the matter, it is clear that there is no compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, this court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition or to pass any further order. Therefore, the petition is hereby dismissed.
