The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner is 100 per cent physically handicapped. Police has also filed photocopy of letter dated 6.6.2013 in Court today, showing that he is a partner in petrol pump alongwith his father, which is taken on record. The petitioner is in custody since 23.10.2018. Challan has already been presented in Court and charges have also been framed against petitioner.

Since completion of trial will take time, therefore, further detention of petitioner will not serve any purpose. Petition is thus allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court, subject to following conditions :-

1. Petitioner shall surrender his passport before trial Court, if any, and he will not leave the country without permission of Court ;
2. Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness ; and

3. Petitioner shall attend Court on each and every date of hearing
and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
