Briefly stated, facts of the case are that Jasmeet Singh Anand had brought a suit against defendant – Ravinder Singh, Proprietor of M/s Bawa Motors, GT Road, Natha Singh, Market, Moga for restraining the defendant from dispossessing the plaintiff from plot No.B-6 measuring 150' x 250' situated at Focal Point, Moga illegally and forcibly.

On notice, the defendant had appeared. During the course of proceedings, Pushpinder Kaur and Gurpreet Kaur – daughters of Avinash Kaur and Manjit Singh had filed an application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC for being impleaded as defendants contending that they along with their brother Kulwinder Singh are legal heirs of Avinash Kaur and Manjit Singh and have every right to safeguard their interest in moveable and immovable properties left behind by their parents.

The application was being resisted by the plaintiff contending

that neither the applicants nor their mother had any concern with the suit property. The applicants are not necessary parties. Therefore, the application be dismissed.

After hearing arguments, the trial Court vide order dated 30.10.2019 allowed the said application. The plaintiff felt aggrieved by the said order and preferred a revision petition before this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner besides going through the record.

The impugned order is quite detailed and well reasoned. It does not suffer from any illegality or infirmity much less apparent on the face of it. The order is certainly not perverse or arbitrary based against settled law on the subject. Therefore, no interference by this Court while exercising revisional jurisdiction is called for.

Finding no merit in the revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
