On the last date, the following order was passed :-

“ Notice of motion for 23.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, respondent Nos.1 to 3 are directed to examine and consider the case of petitioners and if it is found that there is real and genuine threat to their life, limb and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 10, then they will be provided protection forthwith. If the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided facility of Protection Home as per their requirement. However, this order shall not be applicable in case any act/conduct of any of the petitioners pertaining to the application, amounts to an offence.”

Today, learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Chander, has accepted that the documents of age which have been placed on record are correct and no FIR has been lodged against petitioner No.2.

In the circumstances, the order dated 17.12.2018 is made

absolute. This petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
