Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Dharampal, submits that although the Order dated 29.09.2017, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person was passed, however, no further proceedings were undertaken against him either for registration of the case under Section 174-A IPC or for attachment of his property as such. Even the petitioner had surrendered before the Trial Court on 23.04.2018. Thereafter, even the trial has finally been concluded. Hence, the Order challenged in the petition has been rendered ineffective and the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.
