The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.195 dated 01.07.2018, under Sections 279, 336, 427 IPC and 13 (1) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner No.1 is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that cattle was being transported in a truck.

This Court, by the order dated 11.09.2019, had directed petitioner No.1 to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Tara Chand, states that the petitioner No.1 has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and petitioner No.1 having joined investigation, the order dated 11.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner No.1 is made absolute.

However, petitioner No.1 shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
