This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.141 dated 02.12.2012 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Meharban, District Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise between the parties.

As per the fresh report, the complainant party have again not appeared before the Court below. In the circumstances, it is clear that despite getting two opportunities the petitioners were not able to persuade the complainant party to appear. The only conclusion which can be drawn is that there was actually no compromise between the parties.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
