MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.0059 dated 14.04.2018 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, Police District SBS Nagar.

On 08.01.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the deceased Prem Kumar @ Prem Singh was under debt as he had taken money from various persons on the pretext of sending them abroad. It is further contended that alleged suicide note (Annexure R-1), which attributes abetment to various persons and police officials as well as the petitioner may not acquire significance except for

the fact that the deceased was under debts and he was unable to clear the same.

Adjourned to 06.3.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 08.01.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Mohinder submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.01.2019, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
