HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Ramandeep and Arshdeep Singh Dhaliwal, the petitioners before me, seek protection to their life and liberty. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 16. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 16. They have placed on record the certificate and photographs (Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively) evidencing their marriage. They have submitted a representation dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No. 2.

Vide order dated 23.09.2019, notice of motion was issued to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Today, short reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tapa, District Barnala, has been filed in the Court. The same is taken on record.

In para No.4 of the reply, it is mentioned that on 15.11.2019, petitioner No.1 got her statement recorded alongwith an affidavit, duly corroborated by her husband-Arshdeep Singh, stating that neither they have

any apprehension of danger from the private respondents nor they want any protection from them.

However, without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of this petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is still perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
