GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 68 dated 30.5.2017 under Sections Information Technology Act and 66(E), 67 of 2000, Police Station Division-6, Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 14.9.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Rohit Arora and

also of petitioner/accused Karan Dhingra have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant and injured have specifically stated that the matter has been compromised and they do not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar opined that the compromise arrived between the parties is without any pressure or coercion in any manner and the compromise is valid.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 68 dated 30.5.2017 under Sections Information Technology Act and 66(E), 67 of 2000, Police Station Division-6, Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
