Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sunil alias Sonu, in case FIR No.846 dated 21.08.2017, registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 332, 353, 186, 307 read with Section 34 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

According to the prosecution, on 21.08.2017, receipt of written complaint from S.I. Mahender Singh that a Swift car bearing registration No. HR-99-A-BM(T)-0020 was parked in front of house of Sonu, when the police party reached the spot, searched the car and asked four persons sitting therein, they fired upon the police party with their country made pistols. Out of those four persons, who had fired upon the police party, is Sonu, petitioner herein.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no police

personnel has received any fire arm injury. Petitioner is in custody since 02.07.2018. Conclusion of trial shall take long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the bail to the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner is in custody. Conclusion of trial may take sufficient long time but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sunil alias Sonu, is ordered to be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
