MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.901 dated 14.11.2018 registered under Sections 153-A, 294 and 295-A Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar, Palwal.

On 10.01.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Reply filed. Petitioner is alleged to have sent a video clip to the police abusing Gujjar community on the basis of which present FIR has been registered.
Petitioner is directed to join the investigation and disclose all the facts to the police. Let the police also verify the facts and circumstances under which the crime was committed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the compliance of the conditions contained under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
Adjourned to 4.2.2019.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 10.01.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Makhan Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.01.2019, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
