HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The case was listed on 10.12.2019. Since there were 44-45 relatives of petitioner No.1 in the High Court premises, the case was adjourned to 11.12.2019. Even on 11.12.2019, the petitioners could not appear before this Court because of threat. On the said date, respondent No.4 Kaur Singh who is father of petitioner No.1 was present in the Court.

Today, Kaur Singh is represented through Ms. Kusam Raj, Advocate and is stated that FIR has been got registered on 19.12.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that since there is regular threats to the petitioners, they be granted a liberty to appear before the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and a direction be issued to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to consider their grievance and pass an appropriate order for granting them security if any threat to their life

and liberty is perceived.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Rahul Mohan, DAG, Haryana accepts notice of behalf of the respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of this petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Considering the grievance of the petitioners, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar is directed to provide them adequate security, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 prays that parents of petitioner No.1 want to meet her.

At this stage, this prayer is declined.

Petition stands disposed of.
