1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing transfer order Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2019 on account of the same being in derogation of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (Annexure P/2) and further for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to transfer the petitioner as per his merit at Government Sr. Secondary School, Ranilla or to adjust the petitioner at a nearby vacant station.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has served legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 04.10.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 04.10.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claim, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 04.10.2019, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
