Prayer is for direction to the trial court to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.63, dated 26.10.2018, registered under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station GRP Pathankot, District Govt. Rly. Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 02.02.2019. However, although, the petitioner furnished bail bonds, he was not released as he was in custody in some other case under the NDPS Act. Learned counsel further submits that since the petitioner is resident of Jalandhar, therefore, he could not appear before the Court, although, having been released on 24.04.2019, resulting in cancellation of order granting bail and forfeiture of bail/surety bonds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly admits that apart from the present case, the petitioner is also involved in two other criminal cases under the NDPS Act.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, if the petitioner surrender before the learned trial court and apply for bail, the same shall be decided by the Court within one week.
