It is alleged that the petitioners are live in relationship and thus, they fear for their lives and liberty at the hands of their respective relatives i.e. private respondents. A representation dated 9.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted to respondent No.2 but he has not taken any action thereupon.

As per averments in the petition, both the petitioners are major and living together on account of their free will.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Five copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to serve the private respondents or to seek a reply from any one of the respondents.

Since the petitioners are major, they have the right to live their lives according to their wishes. This is however, subject to rider that no law

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation 9.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) and to provide necessary protection to them in case the same is required.

This order however, shall not bar any other proceedings may be initiated, in accordance with law.
