Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents. Learned State counsel has produced the statement of petitioner-Baljit Singh @ Babbu wherein it is stated by him that as on today he has no threat.

It is further stated that a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for restitution of conjugal rights against petitioner No.2 is pending adjudication before the competent Court at Fazilka.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No. 4 and 5

i.e. the parents of petitioner No. 2 does not dispute this fact that

petitioner No. 2 is presently residing with her parents and the said petition brought by petitioner No. 1 is pending.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition.

The petition is disposed of as infructuous.
