GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.119, dated 10.6.2018, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, under Sections 22 of NDPS Act.
2. The allegations, in nutshell, against the petitioner are that she was found in possession of 400 tablets of Tridol containing 'Tramadol Hydrochloride'.
3. The petitioner seeks grant of bail mainly on compassionate grounds being a lady, aged about 60 years and also on account of the fact that her husband Gurbakash Singh is paralytic.
4. Vide order dated 14.12.2018, this Court had directed the learned State counsel to get the aforesaid facts verified and to submit a status report.

5. The learned State counsel has today filed a status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Davinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police (R), Bathinda, wherein it has been reported that upon verification it was found that husband of the petitioner namely Gurbakash Singh had been admitted in Sarvesh Divya Hospital, Namdev Gate, Near Tinkoni, G.T. Road, Bathinda, for Bilateral MCA - Left sided Hemiplegia and is presently in a stable condition and could walk with the help of a stick.
6. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner is a lady, aged about 60 years and her husband is having some ailments and also that the petitioner is not stated to be involved in other identical case and that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 8 months, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of regular bail. The petition, as such, is accepted and petitioner-Jaswinder Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
7. This petition stands accepted accordingly.
