Reply of Mr. Yashpal Singh, HPS, Deputy superintendent
of Police, Palwal, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 filed today in the Court.
The same is taken on record.

In the present petition petitioner prays for grant of parole in
order to enable him to attend the marriage of his real sister namely, Wasima
Bano, under the provisions of Section 3 of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners
(Temporary Release) Act, 1988.

In the reply, respondents No.1 to 3 have stated that on
enquiry was made in which it has come to light that the sister of the petitioner
is going to be married on 05.01.2020 but it has also been stated in the affidavit

that the petitioner is accused of heinous crime and in case permission is granted, he may abscond.

The petitioner has relied upon representation made vide Annexure P-2, which is purportedly made by the Sarpanch of the village.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, be that as it may, the representative of the petitioner will file a fresh application/representation to the competent authority within a period of two days so that the same may be decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the same will be disposed of in accordance with law within the period of three days from the receipt of the copy of the representation.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the State-respondents that in case fresh application/representation by the petitioner is filed then the same shall be disposed of in accordance with law thereafter.
