On the asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Dadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Ms. Sonia G. Singh, Advocate, has filed power of attorney on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Anil Sharma, Reader to Financial Commissioner, submits that there were two revision petitions, which have been preferred by the petitioners i.e. ROR No.445 of 2017-18 and ROR No.446 of 2017-18. In both these revision petitions, the pleadings are identical, because of which the observations have been made, as have been found in the order dated 30.10.2019 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana. Counsel for the State has explained this fact with reference to the record, which is available with him.

Counsel for the petitioners as well as the private respondents did not dispute the assertion of the counsel for the State, however,

keeping in view the fact that there is mention of some of the land, which is not even the subject matter of the revision petition and the dispute, the order dated 30.10.2019 (Annexure P-12) is set aside and the case is remanded back to the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, for fresh decision within a period of six weeks.

Counsel for the parties state that the parties would appear before the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, on **08.01.2020** at **10:00 AM**.

The period shall start from the date of appearance of the parties.

The writ petition is disposed of with above observations.
