The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in criminal complaint bearing COMI No. 448 of 2014 instituted on 06.12.2014, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is that at the instance of co-accused Sandeep Kumar and Rajesh Kumar Goyal, he became witness to agreement to sell, which was alleged to be forged. He also contends that the other co-accused had already been granted bail by the trial Court when they appeared in pursuance to the summons while the petitioner could not do so as service was not effected upon him as his name was wrongly mentioned as Dilbag Ram. The petitioner had already filed a petition for quashing the complaint wherein the arrest of the petitioner had been stayed by a co-ordinate Bench

of this Court in CRM-M-29676-2018 on 17.07.2018. He also contends that the petitioner had already appeared before the trial Court on 19.01.2019 and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has already been granted interim bail and has not absented himself from appearing before the trial Court thereafter, the petition deserves to be allowed.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court henceforth on each and every date of hearing and will not absent himself without prior permission of the Court.
