Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 16.11.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has also deposited an amount of Rs. 4,10,000/- with the Registry of this Court.

Learned counsel for respondent-State on instructions from ASI Sohna Singh has not disputed joining of investigation by the petitioner.

The allegations levelled in the FIR are matter of evidence, which shall be tested by the trial Court.
