Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.69 dated 04.07.2017 under Sections 379-B/452/427/354/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition *qua* petitioner no.6.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn *qua* petitioner no.6.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhagwan Singh, submits that the petitioners no.1 to 5 have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioners no.1 to 5 have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners no.1 to 5 shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
