Petitioner, who was serving on the post of Clerk with the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana and suffers from a 70% physical disability (Ortho), filed the instant petition raising a plea that he is entitled to the enhancement age of retirement from 58 years to 60 years.

Challenge in the instant petition was to the order dated 16/21.11.2018, whereby he had been ordered to be retired on attaining the age of 58 years w.e.f. 31.5.2018.

Petition came up for preliminary hearing on 21.12.2018 and while issuing notice of motion, the operation of the impugned order was stayed. Furthermore, petitioner was permitted to continue in service till further orders.

During the course of resumed hearing today counsel representing the respondent-Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana has furnished a copy of the order dated 18.1.2019 issued by the Commissioner, Nagar Nigam, Ludhiana (in vernacular) and as per which the claim of the petitioner seeking enhancement of his date of superannuation up to 60 years

has been accepted and his date of retirement now has been fixed as 31.5.2020.

A copy of this order has been furnished to learned counsel representing the petitioner.

In view of the development noticed herein above, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
