This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.33 dated 20.03.2014 under Sections 420/34 IPC at Police Station SDR Khanna, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

On 17.10.2018 the following order was passed :-

“Respondent No.2 has been duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf.

It has been submitted that the compromise has been effected between the parties.

List on 12.12.2018.

Meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial court/Illaq Magistrate on 13.11.2018 or any other date convenient to that court to get recorded their statements regarding compromise.

The trial court is directed to submit a report, before the next date of hearing as to whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

A copy of this order be sent to learned trial court, through fax, for compliance.

On 24.01.2019 the following order was passed :-

“Counsel for the petitioners states that inadvertently the petitioners could not appear to record their statements and undertakes that they would now appear on any date fixed by this Court. The parties are directed to appear on 11.2.2019 to record their statements in terms of the order dated 17.10.2018. Report be submitted before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 14.3.2019.”

Parties did not appear even on the second occasion. It seems there is no compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending Criminal Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands dismissed as withdrawn.
