It is contended that petitioners have been working as part time employees in the Education Department. They are, thus, entitled to regularization. It has been urged that persons, who were inducted after the petitioners, have already been regularized. However, no policy has been referred to, which entitles part time workers to be regularized. There is nothing to show that petitioners can seek such relief. However, petition is disposed of with the observation that State shall be at liberty to pass a speaking order within two months.
