Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection. Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation(Annexure P-5) dated 26.11.2019 in this regard to the Superintendent of Police, Patiala.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Heard. The petitioners have placed on record Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 and 2(Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate(Annexure P-3).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to look into the representation Annexure

P-5 dated 06.12.2019 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and without going into the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
