The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.295 dated 28.11.2018 at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur under Section 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Moorti, wherein she alleged that the petitioner had mediated to resolve a matrimonial dispute between complainant's daughter and her husband Naresh Kumar, which had been settled for an amount of ₹5 lacs and that an amount of ₹5 lacs had been handed over by Naresh Kumar for being given to complainant's daughter, which was taken away fraudulently by the petitioner and was not returned.

It has been informed by learned State counsel that infact the parties have compromised the matter and a petition for quashing of the FIR

on the basis of a compromise has also been filed i.e. CRM-M-1077-2019, which is fixed in this Court for 22.4.2019.

In view of the aforestated position, wherein a compromise is stated to have been effected, in my opinion, the present case is not such, where custodial interrogation is warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
