The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondent No.4, as they have married against the wishes of private respondent No.4.

Learned State counsel on instructions has apprised the Court that the statements of petitioners and private respondent No.4 have been recorded separately. The petitioners in their joint statement have expressed no threat to their married life whereas the private respondent No.4, father of petitioner No.1 has also expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The copies of the statements have been produced in Court and copies of the same handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition, as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn.
