Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was working as Extension Lecturer in different colleges from the year 2017 till 31.12.2018 with notional breaks but now on account of joining of regularly selected candidates, the petitioner was relieved on 31.12.2018 and has not been re-engaged despite entitlement in terms of Policy Annexure P-12 dated 12.12.2018 which provides for adjustment of displaced Extension Lecturers.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-8 (collectively) dated 01.01.2019 and 16.09.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date despite the case of the petitioner being covered by a decision of this Court in CWP No.16975 of 2014 in case titled as **Mrs. Rita Tandon versus State of Haryana and others** decided on 29.07.2016.

3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing the respondents to

consider and decide the representation Annexure P-8 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-8 dated 01.01.2019 and 16.09.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
