Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.149 dated 18.08.2017 under Section 306/34 IPC registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 30.11.2017. He has produced a compromise deed dated 14.01.2019 signed by the complainant Gurpreet Kaur and submits that as per the compromise, the matter has been resolved between the parties and the custody of the minor child Gurnoor Singh would remain with the

petitioner-husband, who would look after the child in all respects.

Compromise deed dated 14.01.2019 produced in Court is taken on record.

Counsel for the complainant has fairly stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties. He further states that the complainant has no objection if the custody of the minor son Gurnoor, who was born out of the wedlock of the petitioner and the deceased, remain with the petitioner, provided he maintains him well.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.11.2017 and the matter has been compromised between the parties and conclusion of trial will take long time, this Court finds that no useful purpose will be served to keep the petitioner in custody any more. I, therefore, deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
