Main case

Through this revision, petitioner has laid challenge to order dated 18.04.2018 of the trial court, whereby his right to cross-examine the complainant was put at rest by treating the same as NIL.

Learned counsel contends that if the petitioner is not afforded an opportunity to cross-examine the complainant, he may suffer irreparable loss.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without

commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is accepted and

impugned order dated 18.04.2018 of the trial court, is set aside. The petitioner is granted last opportunity to cross-examine the complainant, subject to payment of cost of Rs.3000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana.

The trial court is directed to afford one last opportunity to the petitioner to cross-examine the complainant.
