Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that earlier also vide Annexure P-1 petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for grant of protection which was disposed of on 06.05.2010. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that, at that point of time, they were living in a different village and not in a native village of the husband. Now in view of the fact that parents of the husband are old and they want to live in native village namely, village Ronta, Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, Tehsil Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga, Punjab and villagers are seriously objecting to their marriage and do not permit them to live in village. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that he has given representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab in this regard, however, the same has not been addressed to.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to look into the representation and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
