Prayer in the instant petition, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to issue 'No Objection Certificate' to the petitioner to sell his vehicle.

It is contended that the petitioner applied for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' from the Transport Department in the month of April, 2017 and submitted the requisite file along with all necessary documents and the required fee, for the purpose of transferring his vehicle to the buyer. After delaying the matter for more than eight months, the petitioner vide impugned letter dated 08.02.2018 (Annexure P-2), issued by respondent No.3 has been asked to complete necessary formalities so as to obtain the necessary certificate.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that in response to the application moved by the petitioner for issuance of No

Objection Certificate, the respondents issued letter dated 08.02.2018, informing the petitioner about the deficiencies in his case and was asked to complete the necessary formalities. He was further informed that his application was received in the office only on 29.12.2017, on which date the pollution certificate, insurance policy and other other documents had already been rendered invalid.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has already sold his vehicle, it is ordered that in case, necessary application with complete documents is filed by him within eight weeks from today, the necessary action be taken thereupon expeditiously, preferably, within four weeks thereafter.
