By way of present petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize their services as they are working for the last 8 to 19 years with the respondent on parity with the similarly situated employees who are juniors to the petitioners and whose services have already been regularized vide order dated 31.07.2019 contained at Annexure P-6 passed pursuant to judgment rendered in CWP No.26490 of 2015. The petitioners also caused legal notice dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-7), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
