The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 78 dated 20.11.2019, registered under Sections 379B, 411 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Pathankot.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the case against the petitioners had been lodged due to some mis-understanding between the parties. However, now the matter has been amicably settled.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has not disputed the fact regarding the amicable settlement between the parties.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
